The school shall cease accepting applications for <b>junior infant</b> admission to the school for 2022/23 on	12th January 2024 at 12pm
The latest date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	2nd February 2024
Applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission <u>Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being</u> <u>withdrawn</u>	within 7 days of the date of the offer of a place

Applications made after the 12th of January 2024 will be processed as late applications; the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Number of places: there will be a total of 120 places available (5 classes with a maximum of 24 students in each class). Where the number of applications received exceeds the number of places available, these applications will be processed under the terms of our Admissions Policy.
